



The Rev. Carter Via Founder/Executive Director at Crossing Thresholds Inc.

Carter was born in North Carolina, and raised in Charlottesville, Virginia. He received his BA at Wake Forest University, and his Masters of Divinity at Princeton Theological Seminary. In 1987, he was ordained as a Presbyterian minister (PCUSA) and served The Reformed Church in Bronxville, New York.

In 1992, Carter left the church and became the founder and executive director of Bridges to Community Inc., a non-profit engaged in community development projects across Nicaragua. For nearly 10 years, he led hundreds of trips to Nicaragua for high school students, college students, families, churches, civic groups, and business leaders. In the late 1990's, Carter was introduced to the late Kenyan legend Dr. Wangari Maathai – founder of the Green Belt Movement and Nobel Peace Laureate (2004). Together they designed the Green Belt Safaris – a 15 day travel adventure to Kenya involving home visits, environmental education, tree-planting, and game viewing. Carter went on to serve as the Chairman of the Board for The Greenbelt Movement (US).

In 2004, Carter left Bridges to Community to become the senior pastor of The Presbyterian Church in White Plains, New York. The return to full-time ministry lasted only 4 years, and in 2008 he founded Crossing Thresholds Inc., a non-profit committed to building schools in the Kibera Slum of Nairobi, Kenya. Since that time, he has taken more than 40 groups and nearly 500 volunteers to Kenya. Currently, he is also serving as the part-time co-pastor of The Talmadge Hill Community Church in Darien, CT.



Crossing Thresholds Inc. works in the Kibera Slum of Nairobi, Kenya. We find local partners. We build schools. We take volunteers to work in these schools. Everybody is somehow changed.

HISTORY & PROJECTS

Crossing Thresholds (CT) founder, Carter Via, was first introduced to the Kibera Slum of Nairobi, Kenya in 2007. Kibera is the second largest slum in the world and home to more than one million Kenyans. Half of the population is under the age of fifteen. Tens of thousands of children do not have access to schools and only one percent of kids will graduate from high school.

- ✓ Build schools so children can access nutrition, learning, health care, music and dance.

Trips to Kenya are a dynamic and essential part of our mission. Only 9 days in length, these intensive experiences give volunteers the chance to learn about Kenyan culture and the realities of global poverty. Trips are also about connection and engagement. During the first part of the trip, we are onsite at one of our schools in the Kibera Slum. At the end of each trip, we spend several days on safari at one of Kenya's premiere national parks.
