Dove Boxes! The holiday season is upon us and therefore so are Dove Boxes!


This year marks the **49th anniversary** of the Person-to-Person Dove Box Program, which is enthusiastically supported by area churches. Dove boxes provide holiday food to families and seniors in need in our community, while also giving individuals and families the opportunity to share their blessings with their neighbors at Christmas. This is a wonderful opportunity to help your children understand the joy of giving during the Christmas season. Participation is open to anyone and may involve preparing a wrapped carton of food or can be as simple as making a direct donation to families/adults through Person to Person.

Parishioners wishing to participate need only select a Dove on any **Sunday after Service (Starting November 19, 2016)**, follow directions printed on it and bring joy into another home this Season.

White Dove: Fill two reusable grocery bags with food and love for Christmas Day. All necessary food items and directions are on the reverse side of the Dove. A \$15.00 contribution is required so Person-to-Person can purchase a supermarket gift card for each family to buy their own choice of meat. Fill in the back of the dove with your name, address & telephone number and return it (along with the \$15.00) to either Lauren Swenson or Gayle Appleby of the Board of Outreach (details below)
